// CHASE COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTRE

Chase Community Health Centre offers a five bed emergency department and delivers a variety of services in one location. These services include; laboratory, x-ray, Registered Nursing care, counselling, Home and Community care, Public Health, a Respiratory Therapist, a Diabetic Nurse and a Dietitian. Physicians are also encouraged to rotate through the emergency department.

The Chase Medical Clinic is a private primary care clinic conveniently located across the street from the Community Health Centre. The clinic team consists of other physicians, a nurse practitioner, and a supportive administrative team.

// HELMCKEN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

Dr. Helmcken Memorial Hospital is a 24-hour Level 1 community hospital, with a 24-hour Emergency Room. This facility has six private Acute Care beds, six stretcher beds in the Emergency Room, and an attached twentyone bed Residential Care Unit. The hospital also provides inpatient and outpatient services for Laboratory, Electrocardiogram (ECG) Service, Radiology and Physiotherapy. Additional services include Home Care, Home Support, Public Health, Environmental Health & Protection Services, Diabetes and Dietitian Teaching, as well as Mental Health services through Yellowhead Community Services.

Additionally, the local area is served by the Wells Gray Medical Clinic.

// CRESTON VALLEY HOSPITAL

Creston Valley Hospital is a 20-bed Acute Care Hospital with 24-hour on call physician emergency services. Acute patient services include Surgery, Medicine, Obstetrics, Pediatrics, and Dialysis. Diagnostics are provided through imaging, ultrasound and lab. Support services are provided through pharmacy, dietary, physiotherapy and occupational therapy. Visiting specialists provide General Surgery, Internal Medicine, ENT, Neurology, Pediatrics, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Radiology, Urology and Gastroenterology consultations to the Creston population. The hospital operates a General Practitioner Surgical Day Program that includes Day Procedures, Endoscopy, Colonoscopy and C-Sections.

Additionally, the local area is served by multiple clinics.
